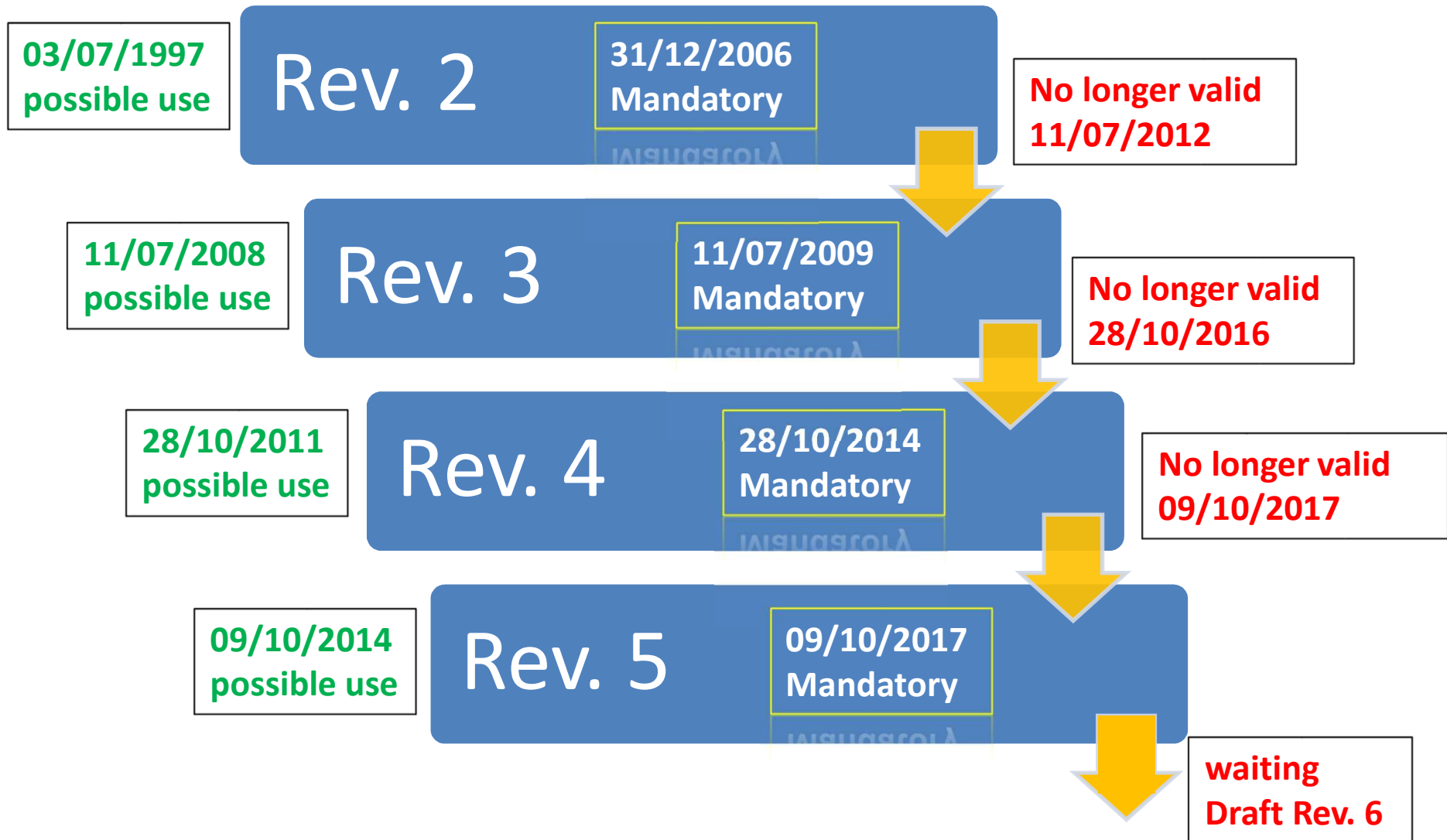


# Timeline for New Homologation accordingly UNECE Regulation No.10 (EMC requirements)

# Timeline for Homologation accordingly UNECE Regulation No.10 (EMC requirements)

- **R10.05 section 13 trans provs:**
- (13.1). As from (EIF 03 series) **11 July 2008**, may not refuse to grant to 03 series.
- (13.2). As from (EIF 03 + 12 months) **11 July 2009** shall grant approvals only if meeting the 03 series of amendments.
- (13.3). Contracting Parties applying this Regulation **shall not refuse to grant extensions of approval to the preceding series of amendments to this Regulation.**
- (13.4). **Starting** (EIF 03 + 48 months) **11 July 2012** **may refuse** entry to service of a vehicle, component or separate technical unit which **does not meet** the requirements of the **03 series** of amendments to this Regulation. (- NOTE: Discretionary)
- (13.5). As from (EIF 04) **28 October 2011** may not refuse to grant new approvals to 04 series.
- (13.6). From (EIF 04 + 36 months) = **28 October 2014** shall grant new approvals only if V/C/STU meets 04 series.
- (13.7). Continue to grant new V/C/STU approvals to series prior to 04 series from **28 October 2011 to 28 Oct 2014.**
- (13.8). Until (EIF 04 + 60 months) **28 October 2016** shall not refuse entry to service of those approved to previous series.
- (13.9.) As from (EIF 04 + 60 months) **28 October 2016** may refuse approval or entry to service of those approved to previous series (— NOTE: discretionary.)
- (13.10). Notwithstanding paragraphs 13.8 and 13.9. above, **approvals to prior series** for vehicle type, component or STU **not equipped with a coupling system** or part to charge the REESS **shall remain valid** and Contracting Parties applying this Regulation **shall continue to accept them.**
- (13.11). As from (EIF 05 + 36 months) **9 October 2017** New approvals must meet 05 series.
- There is not currently any “no longer valid” date for old approvals to 04 series.
